

Fiddler on the Roof

Show Synopsis:

Set in the little village of Anatevka, the story centers on Tevye, a poor milkman, and his five daughters. With the help of a colorful and tight-knit Jewish community, Tevye tries to protect his daughters and instill them with traditional values in the face of changing social mores and the growing anti-Semitism of Czarist Russia. Rich in historical and ethnic detail, *Fiddler on the Roof*'s universal theme of tradition cuts across barriers of race, class, nationality and religion, leaving audiences crying tears of laughter, joy and sadness.

Other Information:

- All cast members are required to become members of Globe (2017-2018 season) and pay a membership fee in September 2017.
- All cast members are expected to volunteer a minimum of 6 hours to assist in other areas of the production. Opportunities will arise to assist in areas such as set construction, set painting, publicity and promotion, social media, etc.
- In addition, all cast members are expected to assist with load-in to the theatre (Sun Nov 19) as well as strike, following the last performance.

Audition Requirements:

- All auditionees are asked to prepare one song, do a cold reading from the script and participate in a group dance.
- Please prepare one story-telling piece from mid 20th century musical theatre repertoire. Please be prepared to sing the full song.
- Sheet music in your correct key is required. Please have it double-sided, hole punched and in a 3 ring binder. A pianist will be provided. Karaoke tracks are not accepted as accompaniment.
- The group dance audition will occur in the middle of each afternoon/evening audition block (Sunday afternoon 2:30-3:15pm and Tuesday evening 8:15-9:00pm). Anyone who has an audition time before 2:30/8:15pm will wait after their audition for the dance break and those with an audition time after 3:15/9:00pm will need to arrive by 2:30/8:15pm in order to participate. Please wear comfortable (stretchy) clothing and indoor shoes (no bare feet or sock feet).
